Dear Lake City Family!

In December 2015, the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA), the replacement for the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act* (commonly known as *No Child Left Behind*) was signed into law. In an effort to ensure parents of student who attend Title I schools are notified on how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, our district mandates all schools inform parents of their College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI score). The comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, provides a score between 0 - 100 for each school-measuring how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or a career.

Lake City Elementary's CCRPI score for the 2015-16 school year is 78.9 out of 100 possible points. The College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) report has been posted for public review by the Georgia Department of Education. From the available drop down menus for *District* and *School*, select "Clayton County" and "Lake City Elementary School". We have not yet received our CCRPI score for the 2016-17 school year.
